

- When you find a title you'd like to read, click "borrow"
- When the pop-up appears, click the "borrow" drop down menu to set the lending period to either 7, 14, or 21 days
- Click "borrow" once more
- Next, click "Read now with Kindle"
- You'll be redirected to the Amazon Digital Library Loan page
- Enter the email and password associated with your personal Amazon account and then click "Sign-in"
- Click the "Deliver To" dropdown menu on the right side of the screen and select the Kindle you would like the ebook sent to
- With your device selected from the above dropdown menu, click "Get Library Book"
- The ebook will be delivered to your Kindle
- Please note that you must be connected to WiFi for an OverDrive title to be sent to your Kindle device

The library offers free public Wi-Fi, if needed!

If you do not have an Amazon account associated with your Kindle device, you will need to create one to download Kindle titles from OverDrive to your device.

What is OverDrive?

OverDrive is the original app for downloading ebooks from your library's digital collection.

With this brochure, you'll learn how to download content to your Kindle Fire, Kindle Paperwhite, or original Kindle device from Amazon.

Please note that some original Kindle models no longer have secure software that can support the OverDrive app.

Please note that Libby Extras, such as The Great Courses, are not available through the OverDrive app. To check out Libby Extras you will need to access Libby through a compatible device or the Libby website at <https://libbyapp.com/>.

Kindle Fire

- To start, download the OverDrive app from the Amazon App Store
- Tap "Have an Account? Sign In"
- Tap "Sign in Using Library Card"
- Enter the name of your library in the search box and then tap "Go"
- Tap the library name and enter your 14 digit Library card number and then tap the "Sign In" button
- Now that you're signed in to your OverDrive account, tap "add a title" to begin browsing for ebooks and eaudiobooks

After selecting "Add a title" the webpage version of OverDrive will open.

You'll need to sign-in once more with your library card. After this, you will not need to sign-in again on this device.

Now you're ready to search for a title and read on your Kindle Fire!

To use OverDrive's Libby app on your Kindle Fire, please check out our brochure for Android devices. You will need to download the Google Play Store to your Fire device to get started with Libby.

Kindle Original & Kindle Paperwhite

- Visit <https://noble.overdrive.com/noble-lynnfield/content> in an Internet Browser on your computer
- Click the blue "Sign In" box in the upper right hand corner of the screen
- Enter your 14 digit Lynnfield library card number
- Click "Kindle Books" in the top header menu of the website (under the NOBLE logo) to see all ebooks compatible with your device

Downloading Kindle eBooks

- You can search all of NOBLE's OverDrive collection by a specific title, author, series, or genre by clicking the magnifying glass in the upper right hand corner of the website.
- To make sure an ebook is compatible with your Kindle device, click the cover of an ebook to see more information. On the right side of the screen you will see all available formats for that particular ebook. If the format "Kindle" is listed, you're good to go!
