

Notes on Downloading eBooks for Kindle (Original & Paperwhite)

You will need your library card number and account password. Not sure where your library card is? No problem! E-mail lfdcirc@noblenet.org or visit the Circulation Desk for assistance

- You can search all of NOBLE's OverDrive collection by a specific title, author, series, or genre by clicking the magnifying glass in the upper right hand corner of the website.
- To make sure an ebook is compatible with your Kindle device, click the cover of an ebook to see more information. On the right side of the screen you will see all available formats for that particular ebook. If the format "Kindle" is listed, you're good to go!

The library offers free public Wi-Fi, if needed!

If you do not have an Amazon account associated with your Kindle device, you will need to create one to download Kindle titles from OverDrive to your device.

What is OverDrive?

OverDrive is a company which offers ebooks, e-audiobooks, and other digital media to libraries. When you borrow an e-book from the Lynnfield Public Library, you are borrowing a book we purchased from OverDrive.

What is Libby?

Libby is an app you can use to download ebooks from OverDrive's digital collection. The Libby app is compatible with the Kindle Fire. **Other Kindle devices do not use the Libby app.**

With this brochure, you'll learn how to download content to your Kindle Fire, Kindle Paperwhite, or original Kindle device from Amazon.

Kindle Fire

1. Prepare your Fire Tablet. Follow the steps in the next two steps.
2. **Open: Settings > Security (or Applications) > Enable Apps from Unknown Sources**
3. **Open: Settings > Storage > Enable Storage**
4. Open your **Silk Browser** and visit: <https://apps.goodereader.com/category/android-apps/>
5. Search for the Libby app and select "download."
6. After the download is complete, tap **Open > Install** to install the Libby app.
7. Launch the Libby App and follow the prompts.
8. You will log in using your library and library card number.
9. To reset your settings, return to step 2 and **Disable Apps from Unknown Sources.**
10. Use the Libby app to read and listen to e-books galore!

Kindle Original & Kindle Paperwhite

- Open a browser on your computer. Visit <https://noble.overdrive.com/noble-lynnfield/content>
- Click the blue "Sign In" box in the upper right hand corner of the screen
- Select "NOBLE Library Patrons." Enter your Lynnfield library card number
- Click "Kindle Books" in the top header menu or search for a title
- When you find a title you'd like to read, click "borrow"
- When the pop-up appears, click the "borrow" drop down menu to set the lending period to either 7, 14, or 21 days
- Click "borrow" once more
- Next, click "Read now with Kindle" You'll be redirected to the Amazon Digital Library Loan page
- Enter the email and password associated with your personal Amazon account and then click "Sign-in"
- From the "Deliver To" dropdown menu on the right side, select the Kindle you would like the ebook sent to
- With your device selected from the dropdown menu, click "Get Library Book". The ebook will be delivered to your Kindle
- Please note that you must be connected to WiFi for an OverDrive title to be sent to your Kindle device
